With living expenses offered as a scholarship from *Triple R Recovery Charities*, anyone can increase their chances drastically for long-term sobriety.

Our facilities are located outside of Show Low, Arizona and offer a unique experience to not only understand and work on recovery, but to build life skills and plan for a better future:

Waypoint Men's facility (6-18 months)

located in Vernon, AZ is a remote 320-acre property where clients attend groups every weekday morning; learn skills such as electrical, welding, framing, plumbing, masonry, auto, farming and/or get their GED or take college credits towards building a new path in life in the afternoon and attend meetings at night. Weekends include activities, shopping, and service work.

Waypoint Women's facility (3-12 months)

located just outside Show Low, AZ is a remote 40-acre off-grid property where clients attend groups every weekday morning; and like the Men's facility perform skills and service work in the afternoons.
